## SPIRITUAL MESSAGE



THE SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST is dedicated as the day of “*All Saints.*” It is a reminder to us of the profound influence of religious faith in the lives of believers. Down through the centuries such people have suffered hardship, they have been persecuted, distressed, but never abandoning their faith in the Lord. They are the saints of God.

Sadly, in our times people seem to be more concerned with being successful than being saintly. In the New Testament we discern the desire to conform to the likeness of Christ, He was the model to be emulated, and there was a child-like, personal attitude towards Jesus.

Early Christians, seeing the sufferings and holy lives of believers, sought to perpetuate their memory. They called upon their intercession in the struggles of life. Commemoration was made over the graves of the martyrs. And so days were set aside in memory of the saints.

But these were the known saints. These were the men and women who left bold traces of their dedication to the Christian faith. There were countless others practically unknown. These were the Christians who led simple, pious, dedicated lives; praying, fasting, loving Christ and neighbor. It seemed proper to set aside a time for “*All Saints.*”

Believers in every walk and station of life are involved: fathers and mothers, children, soldiers, laborer, rich and poor... people with great differences between them but with one most important element in common: they loved and served Christ. “*Seeing we are compassed by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight and sin that does beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us.*”
