PASTORAL MESSAGE



The story of Noah and the ark is familiar to all of us. From the earliest years of our religious training, this fascinating biblical tale has been told again and again! Who among us does not know that the Great Flood was caused by a torrential rain that lasted 40 days and 40 nights, and that only righteous Noah and his family, along with “two of all living creatures, male and female” were spared from this devastating deluge?

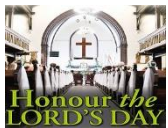
While being caught up in this exciting adventure as related in Book of Genesis, we sometimes overlook, however, the real message of the story of Noah and the arc. Those who live wicked, ungodly lives must suffer the consequences, and those who “walk with God” as Noah did will receive their due reward. Although God promised that He would never cause such total destruction of the world again, we must, nevertheless, realize that the Lord expect us to live in a certain manner, and that there is truly a limit, to the opportunities we are given to show that we are worthy of His love and His mercy.

Noah and His family remained on the ark for over a year until the waters had receded completely. Only after a dove returned to him with a branch of an olive tree in his beak did Noah feel it was safe to leave the confines of the ark. The Holy Orthodox Church has long viewed this as a sight of God’s reconciliation with mankind and a foreshadowing of the mystery of grace, which is expressed in the Holy Sacraments. Mention is made of this in the prayer for the blessing of the olive oil in the Mystery of Holy Baptism.

The Book of Genesis tells us that the ark came to rest on the mountains of Ararat, which are located in present day Turkey. Although numerous expeditions have searched extensively over that rugged terrain, the ark has not been found to date.
