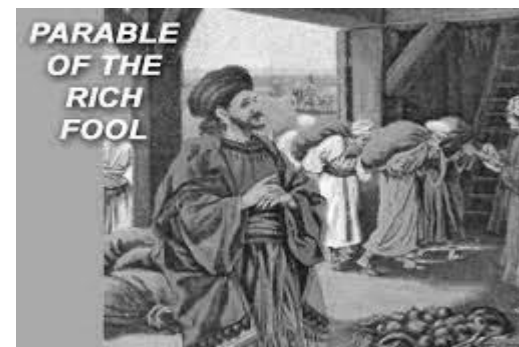

The Parable of the Rich Fool

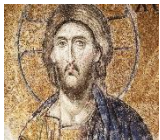


Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." Jesus replied, "Man, who appointed me a judge or an arbiter between you?" Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions." And he told them this parable: "The ground of a certain rich man yielded an abundant harvest. He thought to himself, 'What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.' "Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store my surplus grain. And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of grain laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry." 'But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' "This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God."

TODAY: The Divine Liturgy of Saint John Chrysostom with Cathedral Choir. During the Liturgy, we shall offer prayers for the health of Mary Cheetham and Harry Smith. SUNDAY MESSAGE: On December 4 (corresponds to November 21 on the Julian calendar) the Church celebrates the Feast of the Entrance (or Presentation) of the Most Holy Theotokos into the Temple. It is one of the Twelve Great Feasts on the Church Calendar, one of four dedicated to the Theotokos. NATIVITY FAST: The fast is observed from November 28 to January 6 inclusive. The Nativity Fast serves to renew our spiritual unity with God and to prepare us for the Feast of the Nativity of Christ. Orthodox theology sees a synthesis between the body and the soul, so what happens to one affects the other. The church teaches that it is not enough to fast from food; one must also fast from anger, greed and covetousness. In addition to fasting, alms-giving is also emphasized.



ST. NICHOLAS CONCERT: The annual St. Nicholas Concert will be held on Sunday, December 18th, immediately following the Fellowship Hour. Children, parents and grandparents are invited to attend this special celebration and visit from St. Nicholas with gifts for all the children.
