HEAVENLY FATHER, pour out your blessing upon us. May this Lenten season of prayer, fasting and almsgiving be a time of spiritual growth in our lives.



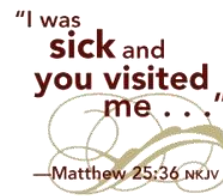
