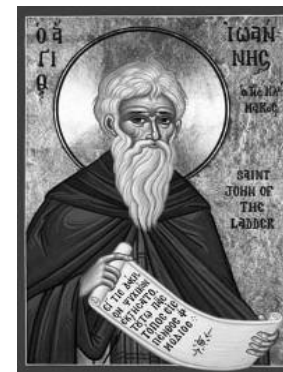

**SUNDAY SCHOOL:** Sunday School classes are held every Sunday at 9:45 – 11:00 am from September to April. Classes are available for preschool age children and intermediate classes for elementary school aged children. The intermediate classes strive to bring more detailed religious instruction while pre-school classes give an introduction to the Orthodox Faith. Upon completion of the Sunday School lesson, the children are then welcomed up into the Church for the last half hour of the Divine Liturgy and to partake in Holy Communion.

**CHOIR:** Our Parish is very fortunate to have a wonderful Choir. We are always looking for new choir members especially Tenors and Basses. We have beautiful spiritual music to sing but we need voices to share it. What a wonderful way to experience and participate in the Divine Liturgy. We have Choir members who do not speak Ukrainian, however they sing services by following transliterations of the hymns and other Church music.
