Upon completion of the Sunday School lesson, the children are then welcomed up into the Church for the last half hour of the Divine Liturgy and for those that are younger than 7 to partake in Holy Communion.



UKRAINIAN SCHOOL: Ukrainian School is for kids and young adults. This school has a fun and relaxed atmosphere for learning to speak and read Ukrainian. Classes are held each Sunday from 12:15 to 1:45 pm in the Church classrooms following the Liturgy and the Fellowship Coffee Hour. To enroll your children or grandchildren please contact the Parish office. Parents are encouraged to bring their children to both Sunday and Ukrainian School.

CHOIR: Our Parish is very fortunate to have a wonderful Choir. We are always looking for new choir members especially Tenors and Basses. We have beautiful spiritual music to sing but we need voices to share it. What a wonderful way to experience and participate in the Divine Liturgy. We have Choir members who do not speak Ukrainian, however they sing services by following transliterations of the hymns and other Church music.
