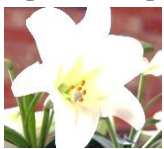
Вхід Господній у Єрусалим

Today we join in with the joyful throng greeting our Lord as He rides into Jerusalem! What joy! What exhilaration! The hope of the ages is fulfilled. God has kept His promise. He has sent His Messenger, His Anointed One to restore that which we lost – and continually lose – by our apostasy and betrayal. *(total message on uocc.ca)*

TODAY'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

WELCOME TO OUR PARISH: Our warmest greetings are extended to all visitors and guests who are participating in today's Divine Liturgy. What a joy it is to have you praying with us.

LET US ATTEND THE CHURCH ON THE LORD'S DAY SUNDAY: Every Orthodox Christian is invited to join at the specified times in the public worship of God, especially on the Lord's Day (Sunday). We attend the celebration of the Liturgy to give to Almighty God the adoration, praise, and thanksgiving which is His due.



TODAY we celebrate one of the great feasts of the Church calendar - the feast of Palm Sunday. This is a moveable Christian feast which always falls on the Sunday before Easter. The feast commemorates an event reported by all four Canonical Gospels Mark 11:1-11, Matthew 21:1-11, Luke 19:28-44, and John 12:12-19: the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem in the days before his Passion. To mark this special day in our church calendar and to observe our religious tradition, **WILLOW BRANCHES** will be Blessed at the end of the Holy Liturgy. Anointment will be administered and willow branches will be distributed to everyone in attendance.

PANAKHYDA will be served for recently departed Audrey (Odarka) Skaobania requested by our church member Nina Dobrianska. O Lord, give rest to the soul of your departed servant in a place of light, a place of refreshment and a place of repose, where there is no sickness, sighing nor sorrow. Memory Eternal! Вічна Пам'ять!

MEMORIAL CANDLES: Worshipers are welcome to place a candle for the health of others at the candelabra on the RIGHT side and in memory of loved ones on the LEFT side of the Altar. Memorial candles may be obtained from the Elders at the entrance to the church.

SUNDAY MESSAGE: Copies of the message by Archpriest Dr. Ihor Kutash are available next to the bulletin at the entrance to the church.

FELLOWSHIP HOUR: Everyone attending the service is cordially invited to join in the Fellowship Hour in the Auditorium immediately following the Liturgy.

PIROGIES MAKING - Preparing pirogies (varenyky) is scheduled for Wednesday, April 11 and 18. Please volunteer for this Parish project. Thank you to those volunteers who regularly assist in this big task.

APRIL 2 – The beginning of Holy Week: The final week before the observance of Christ's Resurrection is known as the Holy Week or Passion Week. These are the holiest days of the year, a time for accentuated prayer and fasting. **LET US DO WHATEVER WE CAN** to observe this final week of the Great Lent. **APRIL 5** - Great and Holy Thursday, Passion of Christ: Reading of the Twelve Gospels at 7:00 p.m. **APRIL 6** - Great and Holy Friday: Vespers and bringing out of the **HOLY SHROUD (PLASHCHANYTSYA)** at 7:00 p.m. **APRIL 7** - Great and Holy Saturday, Acts of the Apostles at 6:00 p.m.



CHILDREN'S CONFESSION: will be heard before Divine Liturgy at 9:30 am. When children are seven years old, they have reached what is called "the age of discretion", that is, they know the difference between right and wrong and are able to take responsibility for their actions. All the children age seven and older are encouraged to take part in this Orthodox Christian sacrament of reconciliation.
