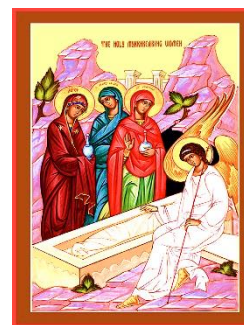

WELCOME TO OUR PARISH: Our warmest greetings are extended to all visitors and guests who are participating in today's Divine Liturgy. What a joy it is to have you praying with us.



LET US ATTEND THE CHURCH ON THE LORD'S DAY SUNDAY: Every Orthodox Christian is invited to join at the specified times in the public worship of God, especially on the Lord's Day (Sunday).
