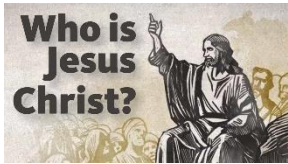

From the Pastor: WHO IS JESUS?

The world has been pondering that question for the last two thousand years. It is still doing so. Even secular periodicals use articles at times that address that query. The Church, week in and week out, year upon year, in no uncertain terms proclaims the divinity and humanity of the Lord.

Christ Himself wanted people to ask and answer that question. He came to the Apostles one day and asked, "Who do people say I am?" It was Peter who responded for them all. "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God," Jesus Himself claimed He was God. "Who has seen Me has seen the Father." The works of Jesus amply testify of His true identity. The dead were raised, the sick were healed, the sinful were forgiven.

What difference does it make, whether we believe Jesus is God or just a man? It makes a great deal of difference. If we think He was just a man, we rank Him with the great thinkers and leaders of the world, whose teachings we may approve but we deny divine authority to them. If we believe Jesus is God come to earth, then we will take His teachings very seriously, indeed. We will listen to Him for guidance about all things. Life, sickness, suffering, death, marriage, vocation, money, sin, war, peace, abortion, and everything else.
