SEMINAR ON ICONS - Holy Trinity Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral cordially invites you and your family and any of your friends interested in understanding "Icons" from historical, artistic and spiritual perspectives to join us on Saturday, March 30th from 9:30am - 4:00pm in our church auditorium for an insightful day. A Lenten lunch will be included by donation. Our presenter, the Very Rev., Fr., Dimitrie Vincent is a parish priest at St. Thomas Orthodox Church, Albanian Archdiocese in Farmington Hills, Michigan. He is also a producer and radio host for Detroit's Own Orthodox Radio, WNZK, 690AM. He has a certification as an Art Educator, a Master' of Divinity and did PhD studies in Historical Theology. A lifelong hockey player, Father suffered spinal cord damage in November 2017 in a league game and was paralyzed from the neck down. By God's Grace, great strides have been made in his recovery and he is able to join us on March 30th and share his knowledge about icons.

EASTER WORKSHOP: On Sunday, April 7th during our "fellowship" hour, we will be offering an Easter Egg "*Pysanky*" workshop. Learn to make a Ukrainian pysanka, the traditional way. It will be easy and fun with step by step instructions. No experience necessary and all materials will be provided. The appropriate age to participate is 5 years or if under 10, an adult must accompany the child. The limit of participants will be 18 people for this hands-on activity and there will be a sign-up sheet provided during our "fellowship" hour today. Our instructor with over 40 years experience will be pysanky expert, Joan Brander who is an artist, author, instructor and lecturer. She owns *Baba's Beeswax Pysanky Gallery* in Richmond, BC. She learned this Ukrainian tradition from her "Baba" (grandmother). Joan is proud to be at the forefront of preserving one of the great traditions of all time. This will be complimentary to our parishioners.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR INVOLVEMENT: Members and adherents of the Parish have many opportunities to become involved in the life of the Parish. Such volunteer participation is greatly encouraged and much appreciated.
