CHILDREN'S CONFESSION: will be heard before Divine Liturgy at 9:30 am. When children are seven years old, they have reached what is called "the age of discretion", that is, they know the difference between right and wrong and are able to take responsibility for their actions. All the children age seven and older are encouraged to take part in this Orthodox Christian sacrament of reconciliation.

APRIL 22 – The beginning of Holy Week: The final week before the observance of Christ's Resurrection is known as the Holy Week or Passion Week.
