Sunday, June 6, 2021



ST. CELIDONIUS THE MAN BORN BLIND

The Sixth Sunday after Pascha is dedicated to the remarkable account of our Lord's healing of the Man Born Blind (John 9:1-38). Again, the Church reminds us about the meaning of Christ's Resurrection for humanity.

On the Fourth Sunday we realized that the Resurrection brought us wholeness. On the Fifth Sunday we recalled that the Risen Christ energizes us with the Holy Spirit. Today we recall that it is by His Resurrection that we are able to see.

COVID-19 Church Gathering Restriction Guidance Indoor Worship Services

Worship services may be held indoors for a maximum of 50 people, inclusive of all worship leaders, readers, speakers, musicians, and volunteers. Two extra people are allowed to ensure compliance with the variance order. All attendees must practice physical distancing of at least 2 metres. Masks are required to be worn by all in attendance, with the following exceptions allowing for them to be removed:

- A worship leader or soloist when singing
- Musicians who need to do so to play their instrument (ex. flute)
 - Preachers when speaking
 - Readers when reading aloud

Worship teams of up to 5 people are allowed, however, only the worship leader or a soloist is allowed to sing, and congregational singing is not allowed. A 3-metre separation of physical distancing must be maintained for the worship leader and a speaker between other participants, or a physical barrier must be used.

During the service, items must not be passed (ex. cup or bread for Communion, collection baskets for tithes) but single use containers may be used. Social gatherings are not allowed either before, during, or after the service.

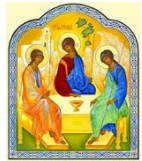
