"How shall I describe this great mystery? For the incorporeal has become incarnate. The word took unto Himself the density of the flesh. The Unseen is seen, the Untouchable is

touched, the Beginning-less begins, and the Son of God becomes of the son of man; yea, Jesus Christ Himself who is the same yesterday, today and unto all the ages."
