
GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS



SPIRITUAL MESSAGE

TODAY - Our regular schedule of services. We continue to pray for our ancestral homeland Ukraine. May our Lord and God protect them in their great time of need. We also pray for healing and peace; that one day, all people will lay down their arms and embrace one another as brothers and sisters in one human family.



LIGHT A CANDLE: During the service, participants are welcome to light a candle for the health of others (at the candelabra on right side) and in memory of loved ones (on the left side) of the Altar.

VENERATION OF THE CROSS: Everyone is welcome to receive the blessing and partake of the blessed bread (Antidor) at the end of the Divine Liturgy.

VENERATION IN CHURCH: During the FLU SEASON we urge the following practice: lightly touch the icon, Gospel and the cross with our forehead. Please do not kiss these items. Holy Communion should be approached with wide open mouth and do not touch the spoon!



FELLOWSHIP HOUR: Everyone attending the service is cordially invited to join in the Fellowship Coffee Hour in the Auditorium immediately following the Liturgy.
